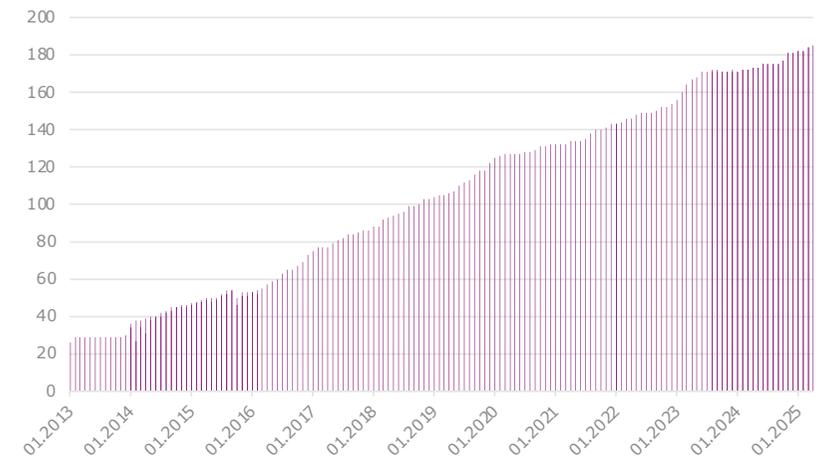

ONE OF the most popular targets for provoking an IT-security Outage

E-Mail Abuse Management*:

refers to the processes and practices used to prevent, detect, and contain abusive or malicious activities related to email communications

The scope of E-MAM is broad, encompassing aspects such as governance, technical implementations, operational processes, and more

E-MAM: A community topic

What has happened so far?

Q#1: Summary of E-MAM-Services

▶ 9 different NREN-responses in the pool (DFN incl.)

- ▶ Revealing: 4 different solutions in place
 - ▶ 4 / 9: self-developped + self-hosted
 - ▶ 2 / 9: commercial cloud service
 - ▶ 1 / 9: RBL-only
 - ▶ 1 / 9: offers access to a centrally hosted Appliance

▶ Among those are

- ▶ 3 NRENS buying SpamHaus-RBL
- ▶ 2 NRENS that are currently re-thinking their E-MAM

// there **must** be some duplicates!

// they **have** something **to share**

// they **have a reason** - that I'd love to know

// similiar **procurement** simultaneously + independently?

// guess what: they are looking for experts who **share their experience**

▶ And how about the others – i. e.: **YOU** ?

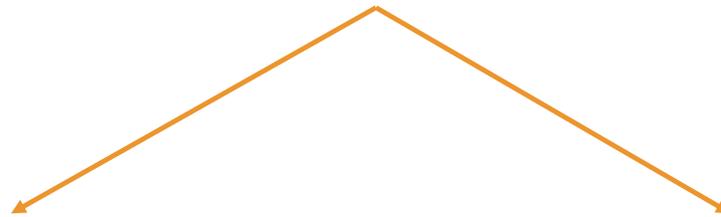
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What comes next?
